Presentation: As the use of alternative heating systems increases throughout our area, so have the increase in response to carbon monoxide related illnesses. This training program is designed for first responders to the scene of a reported carbon monoxide incident. The seminar will discuss the dangers of carbon monoxide, the need to air monitoring prior to entry in a structure, and the response considerations for the operations level responder.

Audience: This operations-level course is designed for fire, EMS, and hazardous materials response personnel who have previously completed Hazardous Materials Awareness/Operations training. This training program will assist personnel in meeting OSHA mandated requirements for annual hazardous materials response refresher training.
